

Background

- Top priority in District Capital Plan's School Additions
- Kelowna population is growing at over 2% annually
- Dr. Knox Middle is the only middle school north of Hwy. 97
- Dr. Knox Middle (DKM) uses nine portables, will need eight more by 2029 - 24% of students at DKM will be in portables
- DKM currently has over 1,000 students in an 800 student school



Project Plan

Build an addition to the existing Dr. Knox Middle School.





Opportunities



Add ten classrooms and increase the capacity of Dr. Knox Middle by 250 students

Expansion will return the core learning spaces that have been converted to classrooms to school use

Helps provide enough middle school capacity in Kelowna for at least ten years

Keeps students in their home - allow Glenmore students to learn in Glenmore

Reduce the number of students in portables in the area
