Re: Two-dose Chickenpox (Varicella) Vaccine Program

BC has moved to a two-dose chickenpox vaccine series for children and youth. Two doses of chickenpox vaccine provide 88-98% protection against disease and its complications.

Most Grade 9 students will have received one dose of chickenpox vaccine in kindergarten and can now get a free second dose.

If your child has had any of the following after one year of age they do NOT need this vaccine:

- two doses of chickenpox vaccine or
- chickenpox disease or
- shingles

To book an appointment for the second dose of chickenpox vaccine, please contact your local health unit.
