



As registration for GMS's Hockey Academy approaches, please read below for information and answers to frequently asked questions.

Q: When does registration start?

A: Registration begins on February 3rd, at 7:00am.

All families interested in the Hockey Academy must register, including those in the GMS catchment area.

Q: How much does it cost and when do you have to pay?

A: There is a \$200 deposit by the end of May, and a balance of \$1400 that can be paid all at once or in monthly payments starting in September, 2025.

Q: Who has first priority at GMS for the hockey program?

A: Any GMS student will have priority for the hockey program.

Q: How many spots do you have available for each grade?

A: We have approximately 25 spaces available for a combined grade 6/7 group, as well as the same number of spots for a combined grade 8/9 group.

Q: When is the GMS Hockey Information night?

A: This will be held on February 10th, at GMS in the Library from 6:00 pm -7:00 pm. Information will be available regarding times within the next while.

Q: If my child is already in the program, do I need to register again?

A: You are required to complete the on-line registration form for the Hockey Academy. These forms are date, and time stamped.

Q: What about previous students out of boundary who have been at the Hockey Academy? Will they be able to stay at GMS?

A: Any student currently registered in the hockey program from outside the GMS catchment, will be able to roll into the next year's hockey program and continue to stay as a GMS student in the program, once you have completed the Hockey Academy application.

Q: Who is eligible to participate in this Hockey Academy? Do you need to be an 'elite' player?

A: Anyone who has skated previously, knows how to lace up skates and can skate independently, is eligible.
