What is LFI?

Late French Immersion is a 2-year, accelerated language program offered at Glenrosa Middle School. It is an opportunity for students to enter the program in Grade 6. Students and their families do NOT need to know any French to enroll in the program.

Students learn the French language and regular curriculum at the same time. Through the immersion process, students work towards fluency in French and gain a deeper understanding of French culture. Upon completion of Grade 7 LFI, students will join the Early French Immersion program in Grade 8
